





Duncan's Island in 1837 and in 1844



1300 block of S. Broadway, originally Fifth Street from downtown to Park Ave.






Engine House No. 6, built 1846, renovated 1875, demolished 1962




People's Savings Institution, built 1857, demolished 1962





Charles Taussig residence, built 1846, neighboring buildings in 1848, all demolished 1962
















